



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission to the Teacher Education Program, students must meet the following minimum requirements at the time they apply:

- Complete a minimum of 54 semester hours of course work.
- Attain an overall GPA of 2.75 on a minimum of 12 semester hours of course work at TCU.
- Complete a course in speech and EDUC 20003 with a grade of C or better, and an acceptable admissions screening report.
- Complete 12 hours of content area coursework (15 hours required for content area math and science coursework).
- Achieve a grade of C or better in all content area and education courses taken prior to admission.
- Complete record of current (within one year) group one criminal record check.
- Attach FERPA agreement.
- Attach signed Ethics Statement or Certificate of Ethics Training.
- Pay the \$55 TEA Accountability System for Educator Preparation Program fee, as required by 19 TAC 229.9(7). For the 2018-2019 academic year and beyond, certification candidates enrolled in the program will pay a fee of \$35 per year. The fee will appear on your TCU student account.
- Attach required scores (ACT and SAT scores must not be older than five years) on one of the following tests:

**TSI:** Reading 351; Math 350; Writing 350

**ACT:** Composite 23; Reading 19, Math 19

**OLD SAT (Before March 2016):** Composite 1570; 500 in Verbal, Math & Writing

**NEW SAT (After March 2016):** Composite 1090
